Weddings are expensive!

The average wedding in the U.S. costs \$30,000. Planning a wedding on a budget can be a major headache. Believe it or not, **it IS possible to have a fabulous wedding on a tight budget.**

Whether your budget is \$20,000 or \$2,000, here are some cost-cutting ideas that will help you to manage your money so you don't blow all of it on one day.

THE RECEPTION VENUE

- **SSSS** Choose a venue that offers a discounted deal with an all-inclusive package.
- SSSS Pick a venue that allows you to choose your own (reasonably priced) caterer.
- SSS Select a budget-friendly venue.
- SS Have the reception at a VFW.
- 6 Know anyone who lives on a farm or out in the country? Have the reception at their house.

FOOD

- 6666 Have a buffet.
- 6666 Buy a small cake for the cake cutting and use a sheet cake to serve to the guests.
- **SSS** Choose your own (affordably priced) caterer.
- **99** Offer appetizers only.
- S Cater the event yourself or have a trusted friend/relative cater the event.

ALCOHOL

- **SSSSS** Fully host the bar at a reasonably priced venue.
- 6666 Offer a limited host bar up to a certain time frame (until 9:00 p.m., for example).
- SSS Provide a limited host bar up to a certain dollar amount (\$500 or \$1,000, for example).
- SS Limit the beverage options to beer and wine only no hard liquor.
- 6 Offer a cash bar or skip the booze entirely.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- **SSSS** Choose an inexpensive photographer.
- SSSS Select one of the more basic packages that the photographer offers.
- **SSS** Limit the amount of time the photographer is there if he or she charges by the hour.
- SS Create your own "open" photo booth instead of renting an expensive closed photo booth.
- **S** Hire a talented friend whom you trust to do the photography.

OFFICIANT

- **99999** Pick a reasonably priced religious officiant.
- **9999** Choose a non-religious officiant to avoid the extra cost of premarital counseling.
- 666 Find an officiant who charges by the hour and have a short ceremony.
- (SIG) Ask a family friend to perform the ceremony at a discount.
- S Have an ordained friend or relative perform the ceremony for free or a low cost.

TRANSPORTATION

- SSSSS Rent a limo for a limited amount of time (if they charge by the hour).
- SSSS Rent a party bus.
- **SSS** Rent a sports car.
- SS Borrow a sporty car from a friend or relative (this could be their gift to you).
- Orive your own car.

FLOWERS

- **SSSSS** Choose inexpensive flowers, such as hydrangeas or baby's breath.
- **9999** Opt for fake flowers instead of real ones.
- **SSS** Buy fake, used flowers at a bridal consignment shop.
- **SS** Create your own floral arrangements.
- S Skip flowers entirely, or only have a small amount of them.

THE DRESS

- **SSSSS** Purchase your dress on sale at a reasonably priced bridal boutique.
- SSSS Buy a dress that fits so you can skip the alterations. Do the bustling yourself.
- **SSS** Rent your dress from an online retailer.
- SS Purchase a prom dress, bridesmaid dress, or other formal white dress.
- 6 Borrow a dress from a friend or relative for free.

BRIDAL HAIR AND MAKEUP

- **SSSSS** Go to a budget-friendly salon.
- **3333** Get clip-in extensions instead of permanent ones.
- **SSS** Schedule an appointment with a cosmetics counter.
- **SS** Skip any overly expensive headbands or hairpieces.
- S Have a friend do your hair and/or makeup.
